## Central location



## Over 300 participants


For major conferences with over 300 participants, the centre has a large multi-purpose hall that can quickly be changed to fit any purpose, and which is linked to areas where you can relax.

## Sights and surroundings

With its geographical location "in the middle of Denmark" Fuglsøcentret is the ideal base for a holiday. A few kilometers away is the charming old town of Ebeltoft with the romantic town hall and many old half-timbered houses in the centre. Here you will find restaurants and an array of shops to suit every taste and pocket. In Ebeltoft you can visit the museum ship "Frigate Jylland" and the Glass Museum is right next door.

Just a short drive from Fuglsøcentret are the theme park Djurs Summerland, Scandinavian Wildlife Park, Ree Park / Ebeltoft Safari, "Kalø castle" ruins and numerous old manors and castles.

A little further afield you can visit the Kattegat Centre in Grenaa with many interesting activities and exhibitions, exciting fish and not least the large shark tank with the underwater glass tunnel. In the covered tropical zoo "Randers Rainforest" you can get acquainted with many free-living exotic animals under the 3600 m<sup>2</sup> large glass domes.

"The provincial capital," Aarhus is only an hour's drive from Fuglsøcentret. Here, there are countless ways to spend a day, but the art museum "Aros" and the open-air museum "Den Gamle By" are both a "must see".

## Hotel facilities

Fuglsøcentret offers you both tennis courts, beach volleyball courts, pentaque terrains, running tracks, football and handball fields, 2 sports halls and a 9-hole nature golf course. So there is ample opportunity for lots of activities in the middle of the beautiful grounds. The centre can accommodate up to 320 guests in 148 rooms and 2 nearby holiday cottages.
